1. ANI Regulator Courses

The ANI Regulator training courses cover topics that are related to the oversight duties for Flight Procedure Design and Validation. These are courses that will add to the skill set primarily of Regulators but can also be of interest to Service Providers to understand what their Regulators are asking from them.

2. Course Description and Terminal Objectives

ICAO Annex 11 defines the State Responsibilities with regard to establishing and overseeing Flight Procedure Design Services. In the time, where especially in Europe, a de-regulation of a previously mainly monopolized market takes place, the regulatory function becomes even more important. This course will help to establish a seamless clockwork between the involved parties in the system. The participants will create their own draft Regulatory Framework according to ICAO doc. 10068 in this course. They will have at least a solid structure of the Framework, which they can use back home as a basis to finalize it.
